


 The schools are still working on the specific itineraries, but your visit will include a variation of the schedule below. We will be emailing those out to each of the registered mentors by **December 3.**

Mentors, Principal, College Counselors, Teachers	45-60 minutes	Principals and College Counselors to conduct PowerPoint presentation discussing: - Charter of the school - Teaching methodology - Curriculum - Resources - College-bound strategy - Answer mentors' questions
Mentors, Students	45-75 minutes	Mentors attend 1 to 2 classes with students
Mentors, Students, AIM High Staff	45 minutes	Leadership Institute (depending on school) - Meet with students to discuss grades and debrief on event - Begin preliminary plans for March to College fundraising - Discuss Trivia Night ticket sales




