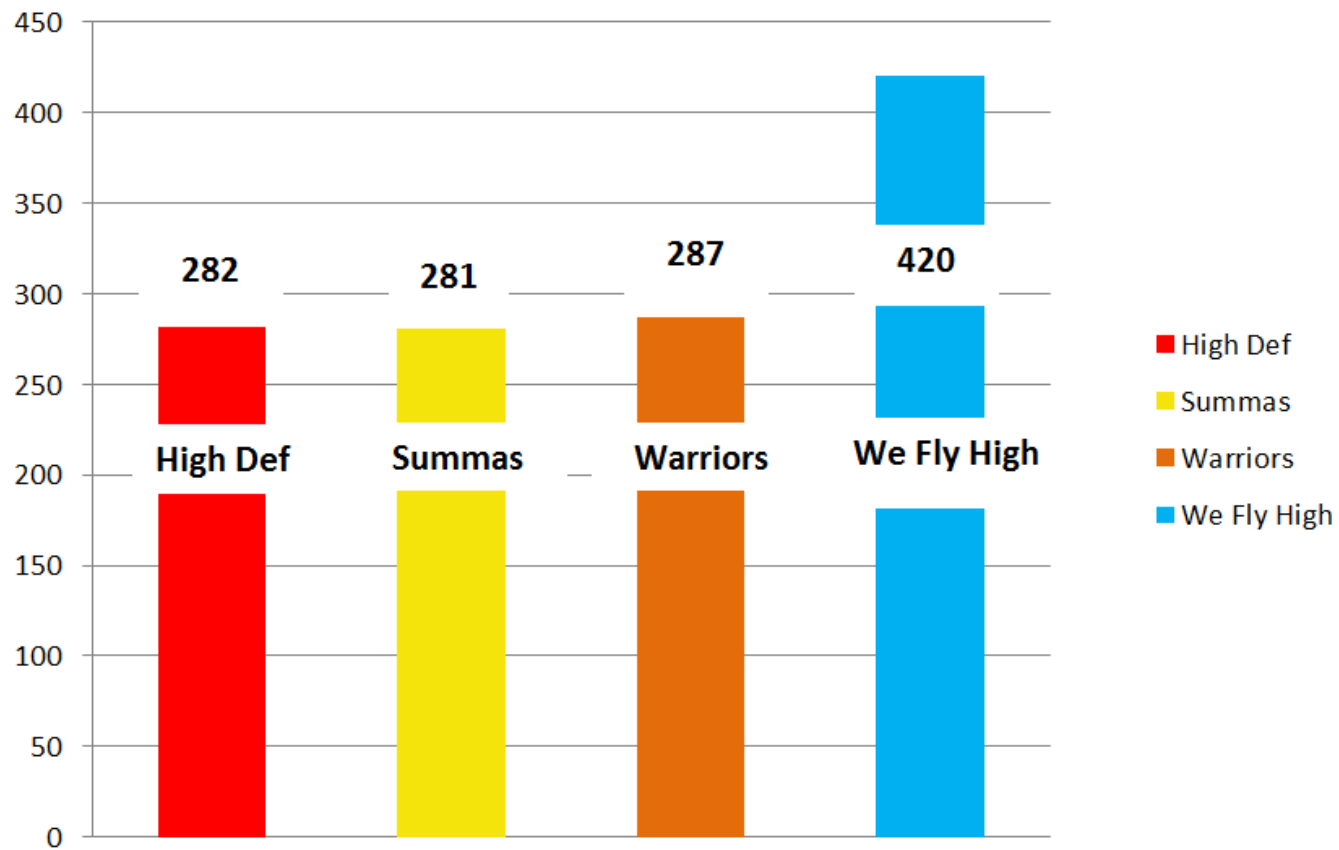

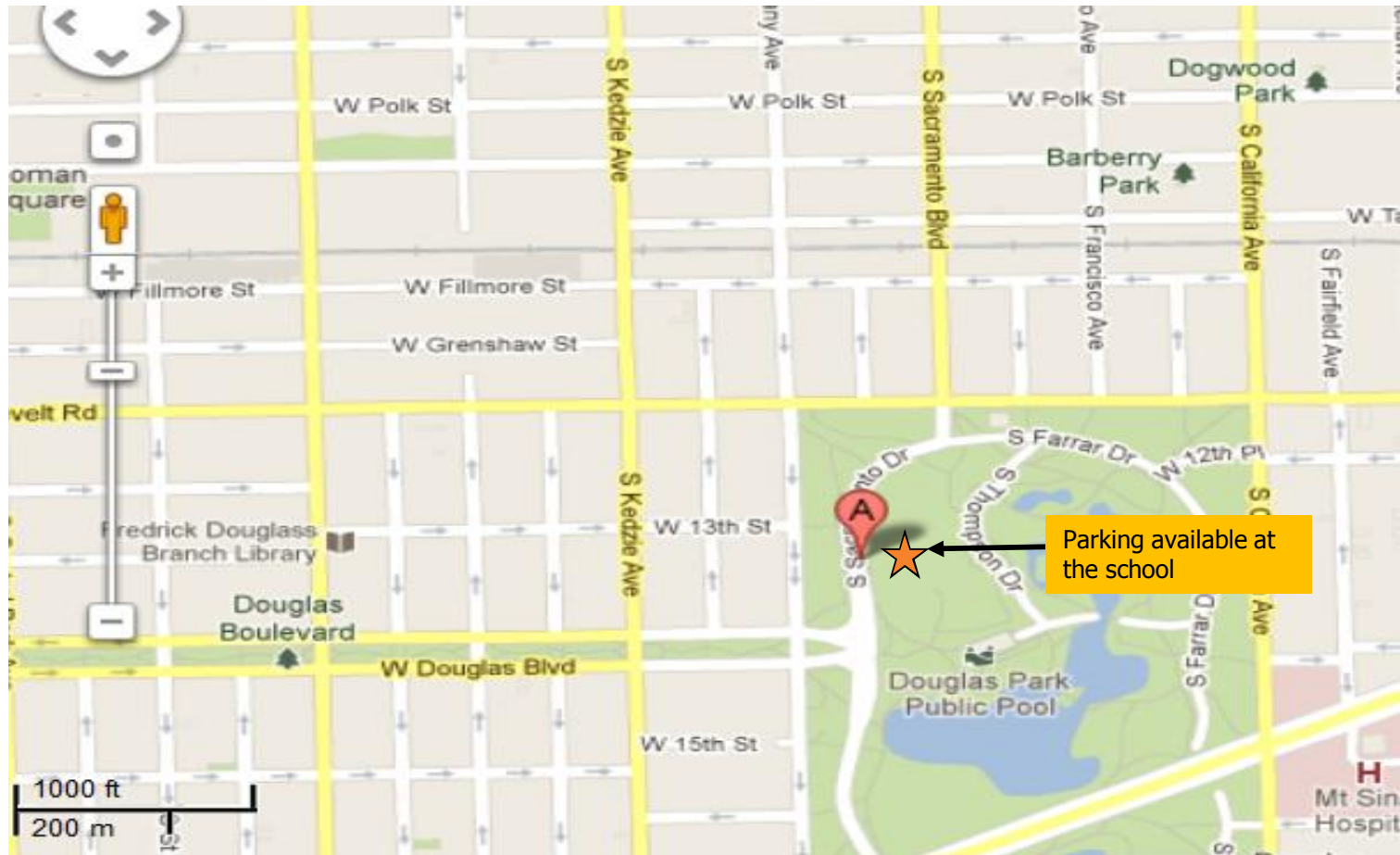

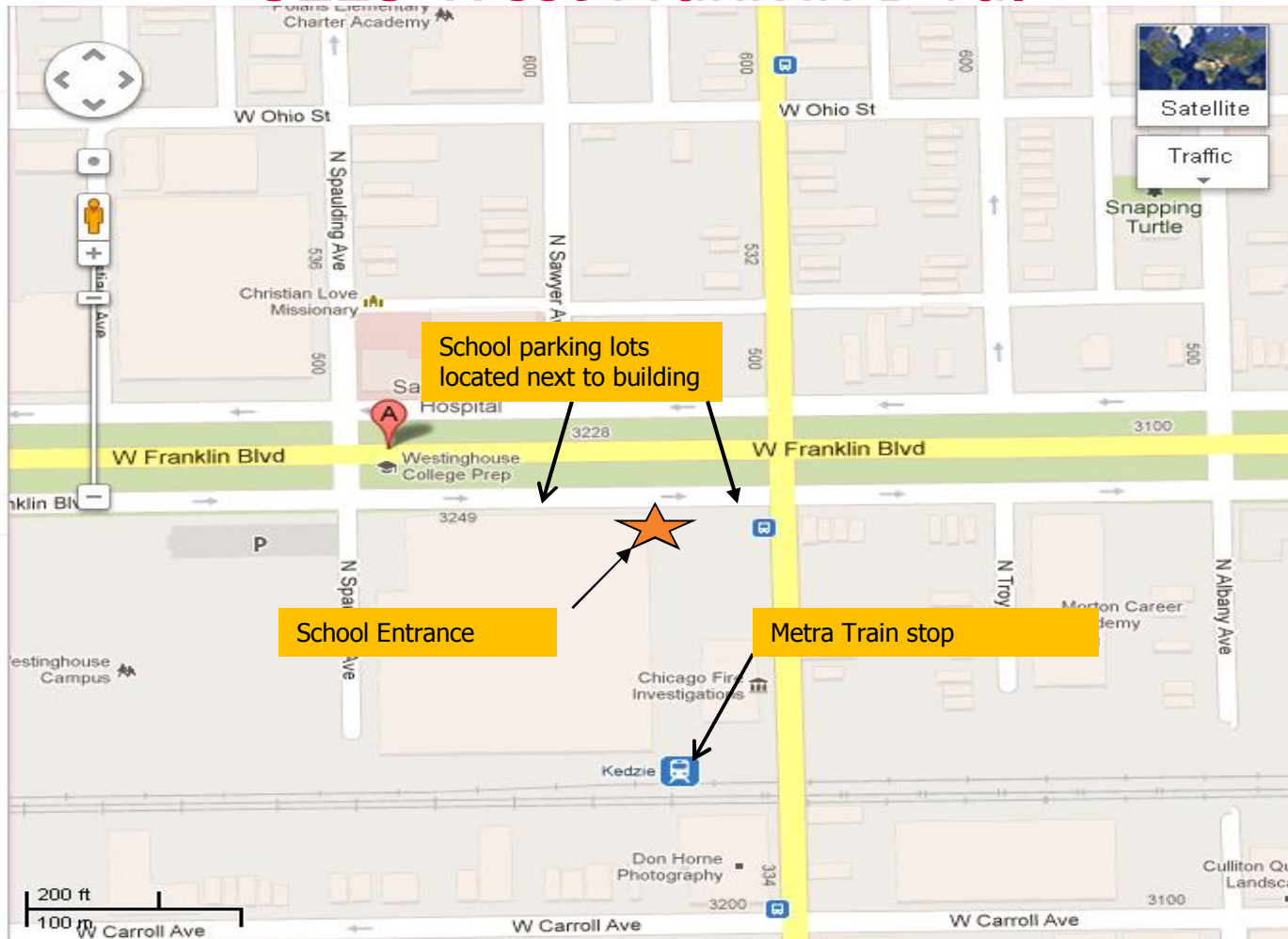


## Getting There

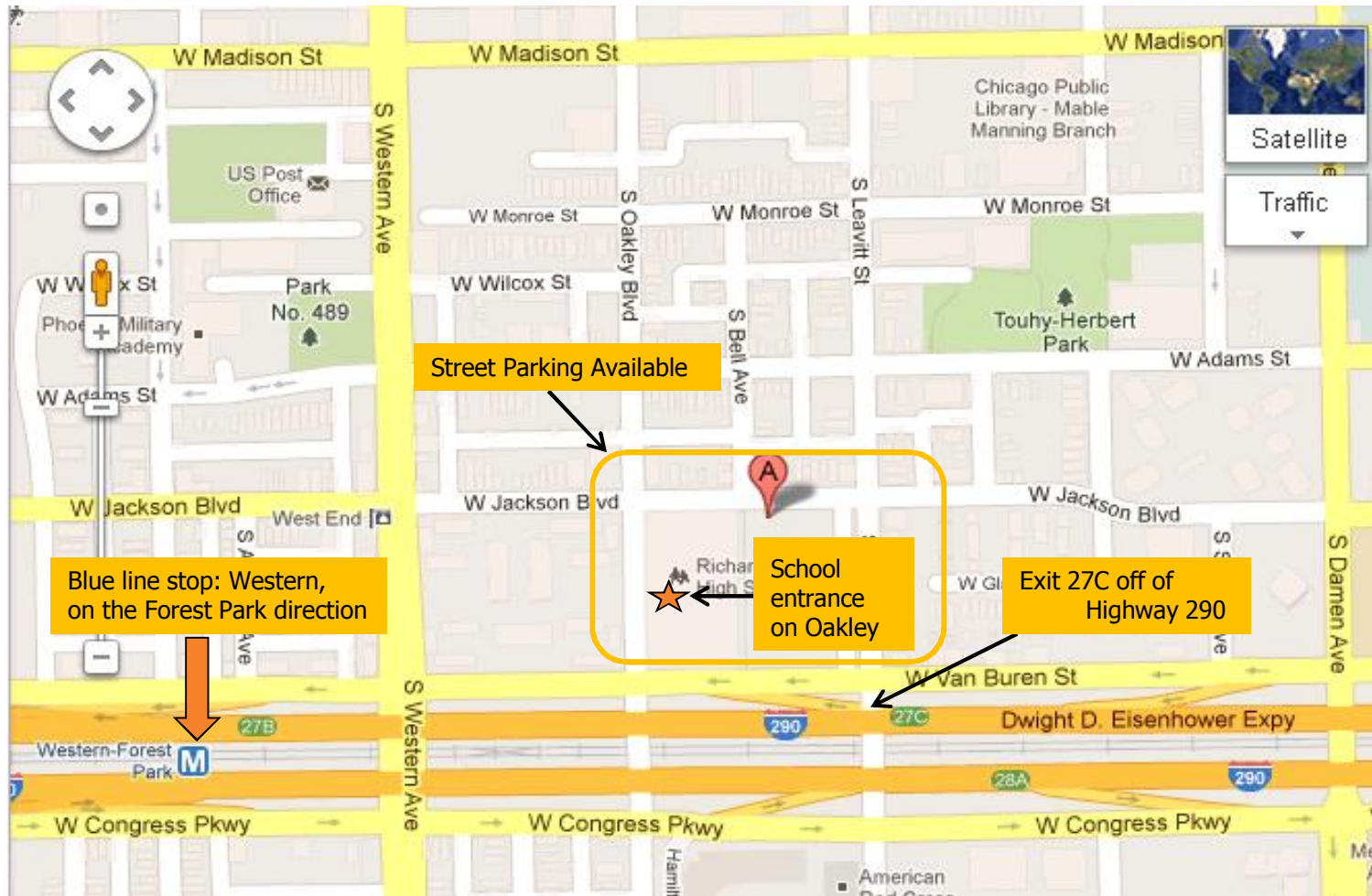

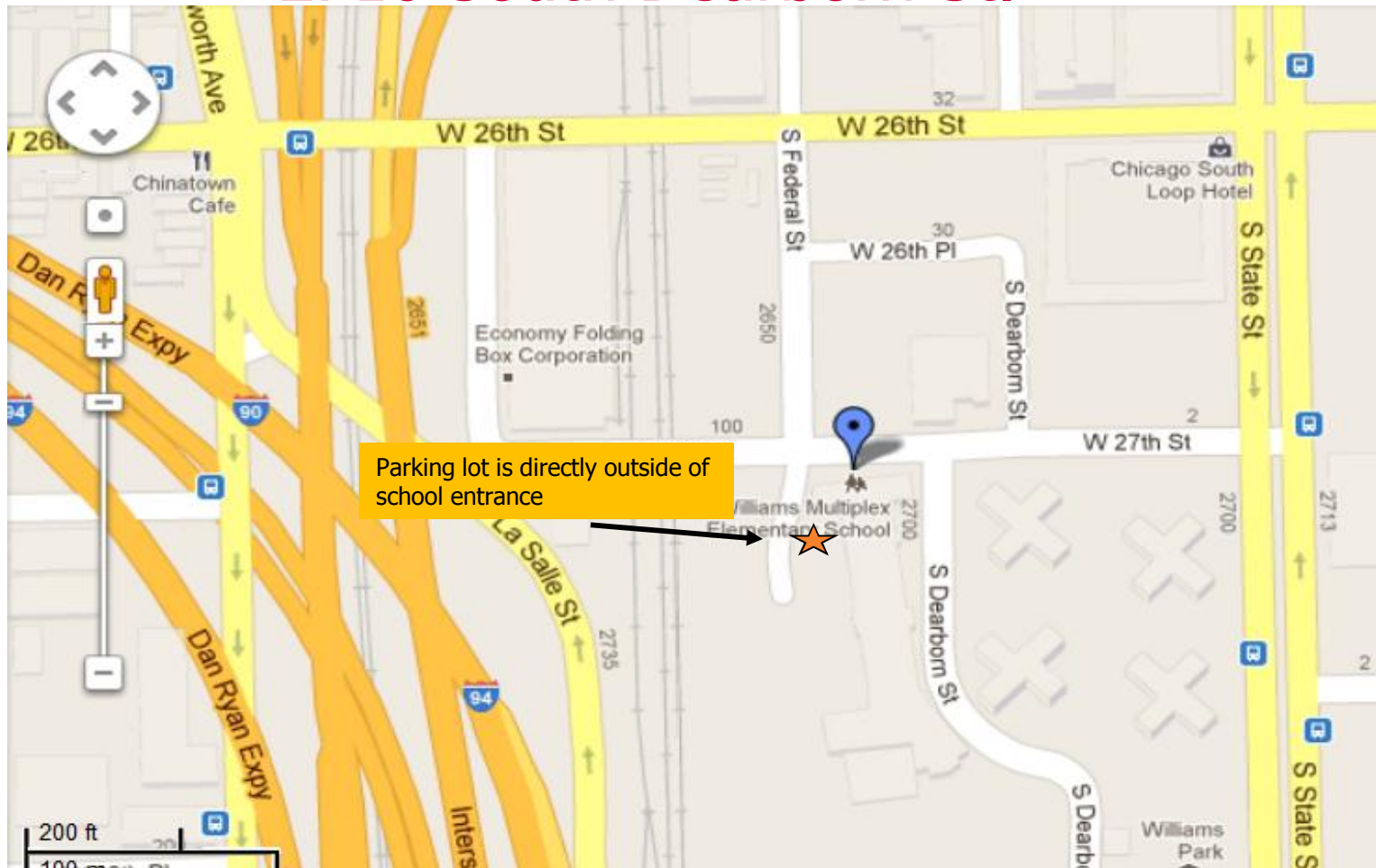

  - CTD-29 bus towards 95<sup>th</sup> Redline to 27<sup>th</sup> and State. Walk two blocks to school entrance
